## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE (Virtual Meeting)

Whatcom County Council will have a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its October 13, 2020, 6 PM meeting, or at a later date:

REGARDING INSTALLATION OF A STOP SIGN ON HOMESTEADER ROAD (AB2020-390): This ordinance is to install a stop sign on Homesteader road for westbound traffic on Homesteader road at the intersection with Standard Road. Council introduced the above at its September 29, 2020 meeting.

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS ON MARINE DRIVE (AB2020-391): This ordinance will modify speed limits on portions of Marine Drive, to reduce the speed limit to 35 mph on Marine Drive from 1000 feet east of Locust Avenue to Old Marine Drive and 30 mph on Marine Drive from Old Marine Drive to Bancroft Road. Council Introduced the above at its September 29, 2020 meeting.


