ACTION TAKEN

Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its February 9, 2021, meeting.

ORDINANCE (2021-ADOPTING COUNTYWIDE PLAN-NING POLICIES RELATING TO THE REVIEW AND EVALUATION PROGRAM (ALSO KNOWN AS BUILDABLE LANDS) AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCE-DURES JAB2021-051): This Ordinance adopts Countywide Planning Policies (CWPPs) relating to the Review and Evaluation Program (also xnown as Buildable Lands) and dispute resolution procedures. The Washington State Legislature apcroved ESSSB 5254 relating to the Growth Management Act's Revew and Evaluation" (buildable (ands) program requirements in 2017. This legislation imposes new requirements that Whatcom County must address, in close coordination with the cities, over the next several years (see RCW 36.704.215). One of these requirements is to amend the CWPPs. The seven cities have concurred with the proposed CWPPs. The County Council has the final authority to adopt CWPPs. This ordinance was introduced on January 26, 2021.

ORDINANCE (2021-004) ADOPT-ING THE TEMPORARY INSTALLA-TION OF STOP SIGNS ON DEER TRAIL (AB2021-058): This ordinance authorizes installation of tenporary stop signs on Deer Trail. Severe weather caused a ill slope failure, requiring a one lane roadway configuration with step control at each end. This ordinance was intro-
