17	acres and included a pretreatment unit, media filtration system and high flow
18	bypass, and a vegetative buffer along the lake front, and

20	WHEREAS , this project was constructed jointly with the City of Bellingham,

23	WHEREAS, the project has not performed to original design expectations
24	due to issues associated with original filtration media, sedimentation from off site
25	and greater stormwater flows than anticipated, and
26 27	WUEDEAC additional funds are required to evaluate entires to improve
28	WHEREAS , additional funds are required to evaluate options to improve system performance and to provide engineering plans, specifications and an
20 29	estimate for system upgrades to achieve original design performance, and
30	eschilate for system apprades to achieve original design performance, and
31	WHEREAS, these additional expenses will be funded by a transfer from the
32	Lake Whatcom Stormwater Utility District funds and by remaining Phase I budget
33	authority, and

35	WHEREAS, additional funds will be needed to cover the construction costs
36	associated with the proposed upgrades. Further funding will be requested for the
37	construction phase when construction cost estimates are developed,
