In addition, Supplemental #4 requests to add 3 FTE Custodian positions in AS-Facilities. This ordinance was introduced March 9, 2021. ORDINANCE [2021-018] AMENDING CHAPTER 3.08 PURCHASING SYSTEM AB2021-148). This ordinance amends the Winatcom County Code to add Section 3.08 (Nondiscrimination) to require all contracts proposed by County staff to incorporate equal employment opportunity clauses. 
