**ACTION TAKEN** 

The Whatcom County Council adopted the following at its June 1, 2021, meeting: ORDINANCE (2021-033) AMENDING THE 2021 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 8, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,250,000 (AB2021-289). This ordinance amends the 2021 Whatcom County Budget as follows: From the Conservation Futures Fund – appropriate \$1,250,000 to fund match for Whatcom Land Trust Skookum Creek forest acquisition. Ordinance introduced May 18, 2021. ORDINANCE (2021-031) GRANTING CELLCO PARTNERSHIP d/b/a VERIZON WIRELESS, A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE FOR THE PROVISION OF WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES (AB2021-261): This Ordinance grants a franchise to Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, allowing it to enter, use, and occupy all Rights-of-Way within current and future unincorporated Whatcom County for the installation, maintenance, operation, repair, modification, replacement, and/or removal of such small wireless facilities for the provision of telecommunications services per the term of the franchise agreement, under RCW 36.55 and 9.30 of the Whatcom County Charter. Council introduced above at its May 4, 2021 meeting. ORDINANCE (2021-034) AMENDING WHATCOM COUNTY CODE 9.32, UNLAWFUL DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS, TO ESTABLISH A NO SHOOTING ZONE TO BE KNOWN AS THE DEARBORN NO SHOOTING ZONE (AB2021-186). This ordinance would establish, as requested through citizen petition, a no shooting zone in Whatcom County to be known as the Dearborn No Shooting Zone. The boundaries of the proposed zone are as follows: That portion of Section 7, Township 40 North, Range 1 East, WM, Whatcom County, Washington described as beginning at the intersection of Heaven the south line of the Plat of Harbor Shores to the intersection with the initia of the City Of Blaine, Whatcom County, Washington; thence easterly along said ordinary high water mark to the intersection with the initia of the City of Blaine, Whatcom County, Washington; thence easterly along said crity limits to the intersection with the initia of the City of Blaine, Whatcom County, Washington;

The Whatcom County Council will hold a public hearing, consider adopting, and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on June 29, 2021, or at a later date: ORDINANCE ADOPTING AMENDMENTS TO THE WHATCOM COUNTY PURCHASE OF DEVELOPMENT RIGHTS PROGRAM (AB2021-296). This ordinance amends Whatcom County Code 3.25 and the Purchase of Development Rights Program Guidelines to revise the program name, update the site selection criteria, and improve program administration. Ordinance introduced June 1, 2021.

ACTION PROPOSED (INTRODUCED)

The Whatcom County Council will consider adopting and may amend the following at its 6 p.m. meeting on June 15, 2021, or at a later date: ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND (AB2021-310). This ordinance establishes a fund to account for the County's American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) allocation and establishes an initial budget of \$1,732,850 to reinstate positions left unfunded due to COVID-19 economic impacts. In addition, the requested budget will fund seven months of operations at the County's Isolation & Quarantine Facility. Ordinance introduced June 1, 2021. ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 WHATCOM COUNTY BUDGET, REQUEST NO. 9, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,138,322 (AB2021-307). This ordinance amends the 2021 Whatcom County Budget as follows: From the General Fund - appropriate \$23,936 in Non Departmental to fund transfer in support of public safety radio tower leases, appropriate \$76,335 in Assessor to fund reinstatement of two "frozen" positions from American Rescue Plan (ARP) funding, appropriate \$32,722 in Auditor to fund reinstatement of one "frozen" positions from ARP funding, appropriate \$567,476 in Sheriff to fund reinstatement of two "frozen" positions from ARP funding, appropriate \$67,476 in Sheriff to fund reinstatement of two "frozen" positions from ARP funding, appropriate \$51,476 in Sheriff to fund reinstatement of one "frozen" positions from ARP funding, from the Whatcom County Jail Fund - appropriate \$237,214 in the Sheriff's Corrections Bureau to fund reinstatement of deputy positions from ARP funding, appropriate \$44,711 to fund reinstatement of one "frozen" Mental Health Court position from ARP funding, appropriate \$60,000 to fund GRACE program from ARP funding, appropriate \$140,000 to fund GRACE program from ARP funding, appropriate \$140,000 to fund GRACE program from ARP funding S140,000 to fund GRACE program from ARP funding Health Court position from ARP funding Management Fund - appropriate \$30,000 to fund GRACE program from appropriate \$30,000 to fund GRACE program from declarat


