### PRIORITIES

- CIVIC CENTER: UNDERWAY. 60% COMPLETE, ESTIMATED COMPLETION NEAR END OF YEAR.
- COURTHOUSE EXTERIOR: PHASE 1 CONSTRUCTION COMPLETE 12/20. SIX MORE PHASES ANTICIPATED TO COMPLETE ALL REMAINING ROOF REPLACEMENTS.

- NORTHWEST ANNEX REDEVELOPMENT

EXPANDED TO FULL BUILDING REMODEL, ENERGY EFFICIENT MECHANICAL UPGRADES, LIFE SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AND LIGHTING RETROFIT TO LED

### COURTHOUSE EXTERIOR



- A FULL SCALE EFFORT TO WATERPROOF COURTHOUSE, INITIALLY STARTED IN 2014
- EFFORT CONSISTS OF EXTERIOR WATER PROOFING (MOSTLY COMPLETE IN PHASE 1), RE-ROOFING THE 22 COURTHOUSE ROOFS.
- REQUIRES ENERGY CODE UPGRADES (NEW ROOF INSULATION)
- CURVEBALL- HB 1257 (PASSED 2019) WASHINGTON STATE "CLEAN BUILDING BILL". REQUIRES COMPLIANCE WITH STATE MANDATES FOR BUILDINGS IN EXCESS OF 50,000 SF (COURTHOUSE AND JAIL), COMPLIANCE REQUIRED 2027

- RESPITE AND RESOURCES FOR UNSHELTERED
- PARTNERS UNITY CARE NORTHWEST, OPPORTUNITY COUNCIL AND PEACE HEALTH
- EXISTING \$4 MM COMMERCE GRANT
- PEACE HEALTH COMMITTED \$400K FUNDING
- **■** COMMUNITY DONATIONS \$300K
- SEEKING ADDITIONAL \$2 MM FEDERAL GRANT
- STATE STREET PROJECT BASED BUDGET CURRENT BALANCE \$2.4 MM, IF NEEDED FOR COUNTY TENANT IMPROVEMENTS (IF DESIRED)
- FULLY FUNDED PROJECT

### **FUNDING SOURCES**

- REET 1- COLLECTS \$2.3 MM ANNUALLY
  - ESTIMATED FUND BALANCE AT END OF 2021-\$5.8 MM, \$5 MM IN 2022.
- COUNTY EDI PORTION COLLECTS \$1.6 MM ANNUALLY (0.01% SALES TAX)
  - ESTIMATED FUND BALANCE AT END OF 2021-\$4.3 MM, \$5.8 MM 2022
- UNRESTRICTED CARES ACT FUNDS \$6.3
  MM

# COURTHOUSE EXTERIOR FUNDING

- 2022 NEED: \$1 MM
- 2023-2026 NEED: \$2.5 MM
- \$11 MM TOTAL
- RE-EVALUATE ANY REMAINING EFFORT BEYOND 2026 (HARD TO PROJECT PRESENT VALUE)
- PREVIOUS PHASES FUNDING SPLIT 63% REET 1/37% EDI (CAN USE EDI FUNDS FOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE AREAS OF CH)
- ALREADY PLANNED \$3.7M OF REET I INVESTMENT FOR 2022/2023
- \$11 MM TOTAL
  - \$7.37 MM REET 1
  - \$3.63 MM EDI

### COURTHOUSE EXTERIOR FUNDING CONTINUED

- 2022 INITIAL EDI CONTRIBUTIONS- \$3.63 MM (COMPLETE CONTRIBUTION FOR EFFORT 2022-2026).
  - EDI BALANCE WILL BE \$2.25 MM END OF 2022.
- 2022, 2024 & 2025 REET 1 CONTRIBUTIONS-\$2.5 MM.
  - REET I BALANCE WILL BE \$2.8 MM END OF 2025

### NORTHWEST ANNEX FUNDING PROPOSAL

#### ■ PHASE 1 COSTS:

- \$5.1 ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING TEAM (HEAVILY WEIGHTED IN PHASE 1)
- ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION \$21 MM, PLUS \$5.5 MM SITE WORK, TOTAL \$26.5 MM

#### DESIGN WORK INITIAL FUNDING:

\$5.1 MM OF THE \$6.3 MM OF UNRESTRICTED CARES ACT FUNDING

# NORTHWEST ANNEX FUNDING PROPOSAL CONTINUED

- BOND FOR CONSTRUCTION
- ESTIMATED ANNUAL PAYMENT- \$1.6 MM
- PAYMENT ALLOCATION:
  - \$800K REET 1
  - \$800K EDI
- WITH BOND PAYMENT FUND BALANCES IN 2025
  - REET 1 IS \$2.3M AND INCREASING IN 2026
  - EDI IS \$4.8MM AND INCREASING IN 2026
