14	WHEREAS, the Goshen Road/Anderson Creek Bridge No. 248 Replacement
15	project is item number B5 on the 2022-2027 Six Year Transportation Improvement
16	Program (STIP), and item number 35 on the 2022 Annual Construction Program,
17	with anticipated right-of-way and preliminary engineering (PE) costs of \$690,000
18	over multiple years; and

20	WHEREAS, Washington State Department of Transportation requirements for
21	the STIP include construction engineering in the PE line item; and

23	WHEREAS, this request for funding is for preliminary engineering, not to
24	include construction engineering, and right-of-way phases of the project, which are
25	anticipated to be \$380,000; and

27	<b>WHEREAS,</b> it is appropriate to include a contingency amount in the project,
28	knowing that unused budget will flow into the construction effort; and
29	MULTERAC funding for these phases of the project will be previded partially by
30	<b>WHEREAS,</b> funding for these phases of the project will be provided partially by
31	federal funding from the Bridge Advisory Committee (BRAC) and partially by local
32 33	Road funds; and
33 34	WHEREAS, Section 6.80 of the Whatcom County Home Rule Charter allows for
35	project-based capital budget appropriation ordinances that lapse when the project
36	has been completed or abandoned or when no expenditure or encumbrance has
37	been made for three (3) years,

39	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Whatcom County Council that a
40	new fund is hereby established, effective January 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2022, titled Goshen

#### 1a. Description of request:

This project is located south of Everson/Goshen in Section 19, T39N, R4E. This is a project to replace the existing 62-foot structurally deficient bridge. This project is listed #B5 on the 2022-2027 Six Year Transportation Improvement Program.

The existing Goshen Road Bridge No. 248 is considered structurally deficient and has deteriorating girders, pile caps and piles. It will be replaced with a new pre-stressed concrete girder bridge.

Preliminary design, permitting and real estate work began in 2020. Approximately \$5 million in Federal Bridge Replacement funds were secured in late 2019 for the preliminary engineering and construction phases of this project.

The existing Goshen Road Bridge No. 248 is structurally deficient and has a reinforced concrete channel beam superstructure with a wood pile substructure. The existing approach roadway has 9-foot paved lanes and 2-foot gravel shoulders and will be replaced with a new pre-stressed concrete girder bridge and associated road approach work.
