1. <u>AB2021-312</u> Report from Emergency Medical Services (EMS)

Mike Hilley, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Manager, gave a presentation and answered questions about the map of stations and medic units; what they will be doing with stations 45, 41, and 10; the meaning of the colored and white areas on the map; when a levy would go on the ballot and what amount it would be; how many medics it takes to staff a full station unit and the total full-time equivalent (FTE) count that would be needed; whether they are making sure they are bringing in a diverse group of people for the student positions; what part of testing to get into the program people have trouble with; and the current demographic makeup of the medic program.
