Brad Bennett, Administrative Services Department Finance, reported on the Fourth Quarter Financial Report and answered how much is left in the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) fund or any of the other COVID-19-related fund accounts, and whether there are any recommendations going forward in light of the current high inflation.
