1. <u>AB2022-257</u> Update on the programs and activities of the North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization

Joe Valentine, North Sound Behavioral Health Administrative Services Organization (BH-ASO) Executive Director, presented and answered what the logic is for having the BH-ASO cover the costs for involuntary commitment court hearings and what percentage of their general fund budget is going to that, how moving the Medicaid dollars to managed care organizations has impacted mental health services, how one gets referred to services that are provided by the North Sound BH-ASO, whether he has any statistics for suicides now compared to pre-Covid-19 and whether there is any correlation between suicides and the pandemic, whether services provided to jail inmates overlap with services provided by Northwest Regional Council, and whether there is anything they need from the Council.

Perry Mowery, Health Department, stated he would send more information to the Council regarding suicide statistics from the State Department of Health and he answered the question about jail services.
