outcomes that are forwarded to the County, getting answers to the number of youths served, and how Northwest Youth Services bills for the services.

Frazey thanked the speakers.

The presenters answered whether youth coming into services have to enroll in some type of program to better themselves, how there can be consistent communication between the County and Northwest Youth Services, whether this contract is serving youth in a low/no-barrier way, whether they have data on the outcomes and the effectiveness of this program, whether case managers are assigned to the youth, and whether the role of Northwest Youth Services is just to refer.
