### **SUMMARY STATEMENT OR LEGAL NOTICE LANGUAGE:**

This proposed ordinance would temporarily close a portion of 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Custer, Washington, to allow Tony's Tavern to establish an outdoor seating area to be utilized until one week (seven days) after the last state or local mandate is lifted that limits the business to less than 100 percent capacity for indoor services.
