SUMMARY STATEMENT OR LEGAL NOTICE LANGUAGE:

NOXIOUS WEED CONTROL BOARD

- 2 Vacancies, current members eligible to reapply, 4-year terms. Must reside in Noxious Weed District 2 or 5 and have ten signatures from registered voters in that district.
- District No.2 North Boundary is Birch-Bay Lynden, Polinder, Timon, Lindsay, and Sorenson Rds.; South Boundary is Henry, Alder Grove, and Hemmi Rds.; East and West Boundaries are the same as for Whatcom County.
- District No. 5 Includes Lummi Island; Extends east to west to the south boundary of Acme; South Boundary is Skagit County Line; East and West Boundaries are the same as for Whatcom County.
